Clean Water is LIFE! This PEACE Team will work alongside Malawian teams to help bring clean water to rural Malawian villages.

Who should consider going on this trip? YOU! No experience is required. We will teach you everything you need to know! This trip will conclude with a beautiful safari excursion.

This trip is open to anyone who is 16 or older at the time of the trip (minors must be accompanied by a parent).

*Additional cost for country visa (approximately \$50).

*All adults going on a Parkview Global Mission Trip will be asked to complete a background check.

*All trip deposits are non-refundable. Once airline tickets are purchased for the team, all trip costs are non-refundable.

OUR STORY

Parkview has partnered with the country of Malawi for over nine years through the PEACE initiative. The PEACE Plan is a two-pronged strategy to build healthy churches, members, and communities through strong discipleship and targeted mission work. Our reach is vast and engages churches and communities in both rural and urban settings. Together, we work to address local barriers such as water insecurities, disease, and educational deficits. Further, we seek to foster servant leaders who will help grow and develop the people around them.

To date, we have trained over 3000 pastors in Purpose Driven Essentials and PEACE Leader Training across all three regions of the country. As we continue to share skills and implement with our partnering churches in Malawi, our Parkview members have an opportunity to connect and grow in their own spiritual development and cultural understanding.



WHAT TO EXPECT

Clean Water is LIFE in Malawi. This PEACE Team will go with a focus on clean water, health, and community development. Team members will have the opportunity to learn about the well drilling process and assist with basic well maintenance. This trip will run parallel with the Parkview HSM Students trip, giving the water team an opportunity to work with some of our own high school students. We will take every opportunity to build relationships and engage with people through discussion and prayer.

The Mosaic Guest House in Lilongwe, with its comfortable rooms and en suite bathrooms, will serve as our base camp on this trip. Meals are sure to satisfy with a thoughtful intermingling of Malawian and American fare. It will be important for team members to have a flexible mindset and stamina for walking in villages with uneven terrain. This trip will culminate with a beautiful safari excursion!

TEAM MEETINGS

We will have 3-5 team meetings in preparation for our trip. Information will include both practical trip support as well as targeted planning and training. Dates will be shared as far in advance as possible, and attendance is crucial to the overall success of the team.

COST

The total cost of this trip is \$3,400, which can increase depending on airline costs.

This includes airfare, all transportation costs while in-country, baggage fees, lodging, meals, travel insurance, fun-day costs, and most incidentals.

This does not include passport fees, visa fees, travel to or from O'Hare, vaccinations, Covid testing, souvenirs, or any personal spending money for snacks/meals during airport travel.

We encourage everyone to prayerfully approach trip fees by inviting family and friends to join you in this mission. The site we use to manage trips will allow you, at no cost, to launch your own trip page. Once you have been accepted onto a team, we will provide information and ideas for funding your trip. Final trip registration requires a non-refundable deposit of 10% of the cost of the trip, which will be used to place deposits on airline tickets.

TRAVEL DATES

The Team is scheduled to depart from Chicago O'Hare on Saturday, June 8 and arrive back at O'Hare on Tuesday, June 18, 2024.

- · Have a passport that is valid 6 months after the return date of the trip
- · Attend all pre-trip team meetings
