



CAMP LEADER AGREEMENT

As a Camp/Trip Leader with Parkview Students, I agree with the following:

- 1. I agree with Parkview's Safety Policies & Practices and will complete any safety steps necessary to lead on this trip.**
 - a. All required background checks, references, and safety trainings will be completed prior to my participation on this trip. I understand that any failure to complete any of the necessary safety screening steps will prohibit me from participating as a trip leader for this trip.
- 2. I agree to honor and enforce camp rules set by Parkview and/or our camp venue.**
 - a. I will do my part to ensure all camp rules & guidelines are followed by students in my group to the best of my ability. I will help enforce all rules, both big and small, including lights out times, not being in off-limit areas of the camp's campus (as designated by camp staff), and following the camp schedule.
 - b. I will enforce the camp's rules for respecting property, staff, etc.
 - c. I will involve Parkview staff in situations where rules are clearly violated – especially in situations where students are in possession of prohibited items (drugs, alcohol, weapons, etc.) so they can deal with those situations in accordance with Parkview policies.
- 3. I agree to keep safety a top priority for both students and adults.**
 - a. I will immediately report any unsafe situations (or suspicions of unsafe situations) to Parkview's staff so they can handle those situations in compliance with Parkview's policies.
 - b. I will inform Parkview staff on any mentions of suicide, self-harm, or other mental health situations so they can help.
 - c. I will never be alone with a student for any reason. I will work side-by-side with my co-leaders to make sure adults (including myself) are not placed in

compromising situations. If I am in a situation where this does not feel possible I will involve Parkview staff so they can help.

- d. I will report all injuries, accidents, etc. to Parkview staff so they can document these in accordance with Parkview's policies.
- e. I will do my part to make sure no students are left alone, wandering around the camp unsupervised, or are being excluded by their peers. I understand all of those situations present a safety risk and will step in to intervene as needed when I see those things happening.

4. I agree to be where I need to be when I need to be there in accordance with expectations set forth by Parkview's staff.

- a. I will follow the camp schedule and help students in my group do the same.
- b. If called upon, I will help with any recreation or serving opportunities to the best of my ability.

5. I agree to put the mission first.

- a. I understand my role for the trip is to invest in students and help them have a great experience. I agree to prioritize their experience over my own.
- b. I understand that this is a rare opportunity for students to hear from God and connect to Him through worship times, messages, quiet times & prayer experiences. I will not distract or deter students from participating in these experiences in any way.

6. I commit to be a fully-invested leader in this experience.

- a. In signing this agreement I am stating that I do not have any schedule conflicts, and am free to lead during the dates I am committing to. I will not back out of this commitment due to schedule conflicts.
- b. I understand as a leader on this trip I set the tone for students. I will commit to be a role model in my attitude, actions, and participation at all times.
- c. Student ministry is a privilege. I understand the importance of the role I serve on this trip, and will seize every opportunity I am presented with to help students grow spiritually, personally, and beyond in any way that I can. I am here to serve and look forward to this amazing opportunity!
